

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

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

➤ There is/are

- In my living room there is a sofa.
- In my living room there is a printer.
- In my living room there are many books.

➤ There isn't/aren't

- There isn't a TV in my living room.
- There aren't chairs in my living room.
- There isn't a table in my living room
- There aren't pictures in my living room
- There isn't a clock in my living room

➤ Prepositions

- There is a table **IN FRONT** of the sofa.
- There is a bookshelf **NEXT TO** the sofa.
- There are pillows **ON** the floor.
- There are books **UNDER** the table.
- There is a pillow **ON** the sofa.
